- 2) The retailers' jitters are entirely understandable, yet largely misplaced: time and again, the data shows that footfall and takings climb once a street becomes a pleasure rather than a hazard. Generous edge-of-centre parking should allay the rest.
- 3) My sole reservation hinges on public transport. Banishing cars is only defensible if it goes hand in hand with a genuinely dependable bus network; anything less would quietly strand the elderly and the less mobile.

---

I am writing to register my profound dismay at the announced reduction in the library's opening hours. I am well aware that public finances are stretched, but I would urge you to reconsider what strikes me as a deeply counterproductive measure.

To characterise the library merely as a repository of books is to overlook its true role as the beating heart of our community. It is sanctuary to students in search of quiet, a lifeline to jobseekers who lack computers at home, and, for many older residents, one of the few remaining spaces for genuine social contact. Paring back its hours would penalise precisely those with nowhere else to turn.

Might I suggest, rather than retrenchment, that you explore volunteer staffing or selective evening and weekend opening, thereby widening access instead of curtailing it?

I would be most grateful if a public consultation could be convened before any irrevocable decision is taken.

The Hidden Gift of a Second Language

Ask most people why they should learn a language and you'll hear the usual refrain: it looks good on a CV, it smooths the path through airports. True enough, but to leave it there is to mistake the wrapping for the gift.

Yes, the practical dividends are real. A second language can transform a career and turn the tourist into a traveller, privy to a world that monolingual visitors never glimpse. Yet the quieter rewards are arguably greater. A substantial body of research now ties bilingualism to keener memory, sustained concentration and even a postponement of age-related cognitive decline.

More profound still is the shift in perspective. Every language is a distinct lens on reality, with its own untranslatable turns of phrase and assumptions; to inhabit one, however haltingly, is to loosen the grip of your own certainties and cultivate a rare and precious empathy.

So banish the tired excuse that you 'have no head for languages'. Begin modestly, embrace the inevitable blunders, and trust the process. The reward, in the end, is nothing less than a larger self.
